### OUR TENDER IS OPEN

As announced on October 17, solution providers are welcome to propose innovative and sustainable solutions to meet the needs of the 8 leaders cities of the project: Athens, Cascais, Differdange, Grenoble-Alpes Métropole, Ioannina, Maribor, Sofia and Turin.

In its first call for tender, CLIMABOROUGH will award up to 16 pilot projects, with an overall budget of 2.400.000 euro.

The deadline for the candidatures is November 30, 2023.
