### More than 100 economic operators applied to out tender

During the whole year 2023, CLIMABOROUGH has worked in collaboration with the cities of Athens, Cascais, Differdange, Grenoble-Alpes, Ioannina, Maribor, Sofia and Torino, to launch a call for tender to ask innovators to propose climate solutions on various fields. ANCI Toscana – the association of Tuscan Municipalities – has published the framework of an innovative procurement procedure, worth 2,4 million euro, which expired on November 30, 2023.
