The collaboration between NetZeroCities and CLIMABOROUGH is now official

NetZeroCities, the leading project of the "100 Climate Neutral and Smart Cities" mission, is working today with 112 cities in EU and associated countries cities to boost their climate neutrality strategies. However, the framework of this project is larger as, thanks to a twinning program, it interacts with a bigger network of cities.

During the month of October, CLIMABOROUGH was one of the first projects to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with NetZeroCities to officially set an official collaboration.

This collaboration, mostly based on capacity building, IT platforms, communication and climate neutrality frameworks, is expected to improve the projects efficiency and to improve the results of our projects.

For CLIMABOROUGH this is a tremendous opportunity to collaborate more and more with other projects funded by the European Union and to showcase its results to a wider audience of cities.

NEUTRALPATH and CLIMABOROUGH collaboration is now in mode "ON"

The EU projects [NEUTRALPATH](#) and CLIMABOROUGH, funded under the Climate Neutral and Smart Cities Mission, started officially their collaboration on October 24 with a first webinar about Energy Poverty.

This session has seen the participation of the [Urban Transitions Mission Centre](#) (UTMC) .

The session aimed to explore and discuss existing challenges and innovative approaches to energy poverty in the participant projects' cities and with the contribution of the cities from Ghent (Belgium), Differdange (France) and Zhytomyr (Ukraine), diving into the links between energy poverty and achieving the climate neutrality goals.

This was the first step of a longer collaboration, follow our news to be informed of the future events.

Torino experimentation starts with a press conference

"We need to improve the reuse of products, well before those become waste".

Torino's journey on CLIMABOROUGH started from this statement that is going well beyond a simple slogan as today the city launched the solutions selected by our tender.

Actually, those solutions perfectly fit with the city experimental strategy of the city, as explained by the Deputy Mayor and chair of the press conference Chiara Foglietta:

"In the process of transformation towards a climate-neutral city, citizens adopting sustainable behaviors play a fundamental role in contributing to the reduction of emissions."

This event saw also the participation of the President of AMIAT SpA Torino, the public company managing the waste for the municipality, Paola Bragantini that declared:

"We are proud to be able to contribute to these important projects, making available our skills and best practices in the field of integrated waste management in the Turin area".

The two consortia that will work with the city and AMIAT on very ambitious experimentations around circularity on WEEE and textile are:

Rivestito, represented by Mercato Circolare, Atelier Riforma, Huulke) aims to make the collection of textile products in the city of Turin transparent and efficient and to direct them towards the most suitable methods of valorization, encouraging a local virtuous circle of circular economy.

TRACCIA-TO, represented by Erion, ReLearn, ERICA - Educazione Ricerca Informazione Comunicazione Ambientale), aims to raise awareness among citizens and businesses about good circular practices and correct waste disposal methods.

The project will provide the City with an innovative methodology to quantify the flows of textile waste produced in the area, also intercepting those disposed in unsorted waste or forgotten in closets. Traccia-TO will also deal with the management of WEEE, quantifying the flows of small devices to improve collection strategies.
