



Follower Cities CALL FOR TENDER



CLIMABOROUGH will launch up to 25 socio-technical pilots through a calendar of two rounds of federated public procurement of innovation calls, managed by ANCI Toscana Open Calls to address the needs of 11 European cities.

After the first round, launched in 2023, 8 cities, **Athens, Cascais, Differdange, Grenoble-Alpes, Ioannina, Maribor, Sofia and Turin**, could select 15 solutions for an overall budget of about 1.800.000 euro that are now being deployed.

Following this first call, CLIMABOROUGH is publishing a new tender **to provide to 5 European cities the services and products corresponding to their needs.**

To this end, ANCI Toscana has launched a call for tender using the instrument of the Innovation Partnership and structured in 5 distinct lots, each worth **240.000 euro** to be assigned to 2 distinct economic operators.

CLIMABOROUGH has worked in collaboration with these 5 follower cities, **Prijedor, Pilsen, Issy-les-Moulineaux, Sofia and Grenoble-Alpes Métropole**, to replicate the process already completed by the above mentioned cities and to ask innovators to propose climate solutions on various fields.

The call for tender is now open and it will close its phase 1 by **May 9 at 23.59 CEST**.
