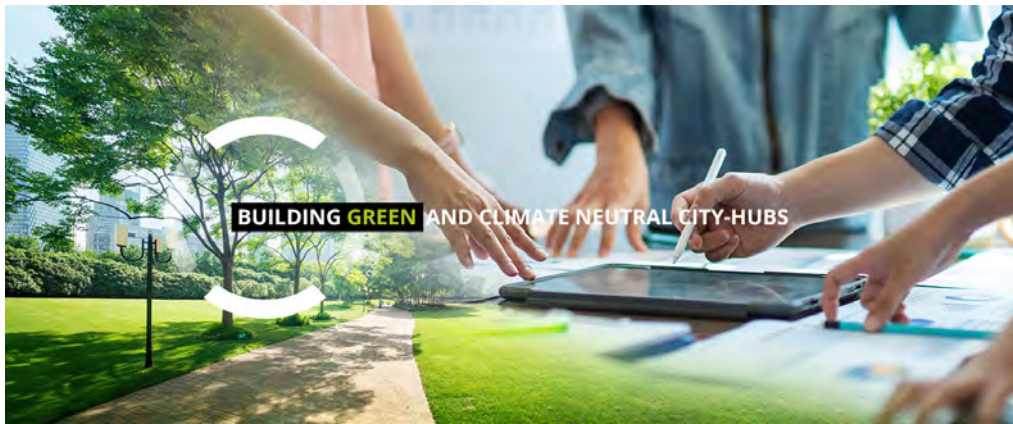

Our Follower Cities CALL FOR TENDER



On March 25, CLIMABOROUGH has published a new call for tender **to provide to 5 European cities the services and products corresponding to their needs.**

To this end, ANCI Toscana has launched a call for tender using the instrument of the Innovation Partnership and structured in 5 distinct lots, each worth **240.000 euro** to be assigned to 2 distinct economic operators.

CLIMABOROUGH has worked in collaboration with these 5 follower cities, **Prijedor, Pilsen, Issy-les-Moulineaux, Sofia and Grenoble-Alpes Métropole**, to replicate the process already completed by the above mentioned cities and to ask innovators to propose climate solutions on various fields.

The call for tender is now open and it will close its phase 1 by **May 9 at 23.59 CEST.**

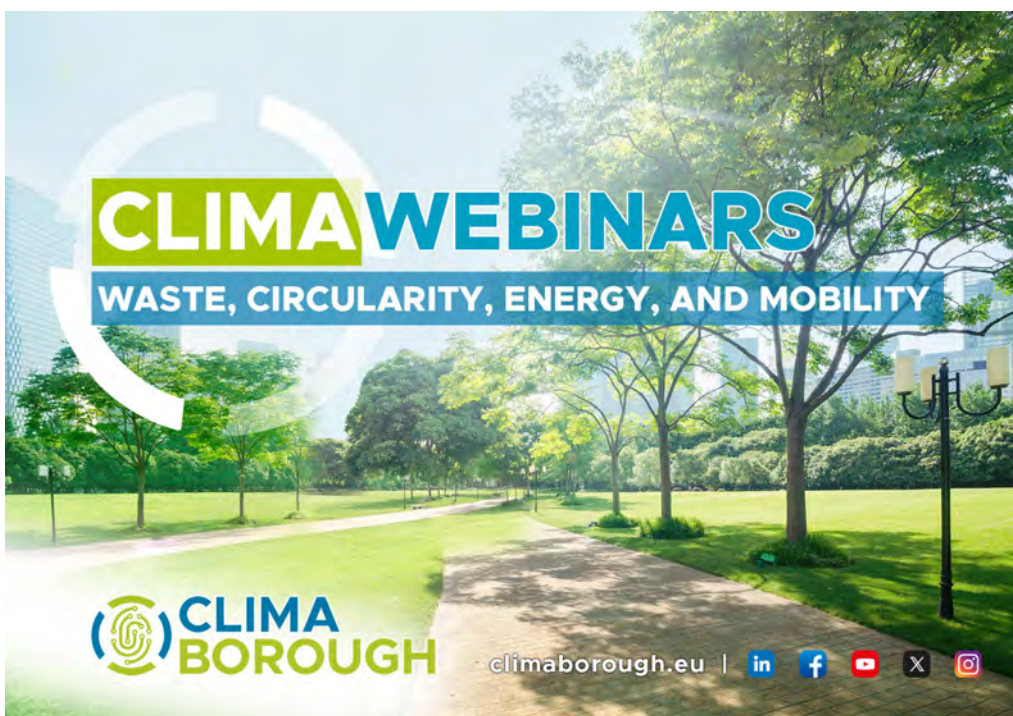
