

Decree of the Director General N. 177/25/I dated 30 July 2025

Admission of the “Emmaüs Connect+Synergie IT” Consortium to second phase of the Innovation Partnership entitled “Building green and climate neutral city hubs across European cities (II edition - follower cities)” – contract notice 300530-2025 changing the previous version 193321-2025 – published under the framework of the CLIMABOROUGH project on the OJ S 90/2025 of 12/05/2025 and earlier on the OJ S 60/2025 of 26/03/2025.

I, the undersigned Simone Gheri, Director General of Anci Toscana

- in my position of Single Responsible Person (RUP in Italian language) for the aforementioned public procurement procedure, as stipulated in the Tender documentation published on 26 March 2025 on TED – the online Supplement of the Official Journal of the European Union – as well as on the official website of the CLIMABOROUGH project in a dedicated section available at: <https://climaborough.eu/public-procurement/follower-cities-climaborough-tender/>

Whereas:

- With Decree no. 170/25/ of 22 July 2025 the list of applicants admitted to the second phase of the tender procedure was approved;
- On 23 July 2025, the applicant “398-Synergie IT”, member of the consortium renamed “Emmaüs Connect+Synergie IT” for evaluation purposes in Lot Grenoble, communicated by email its intention to withdraw from the consortium;
- On the same date, 23 July 2025, the undersigned RUP reconvened the Evaluation Committee in order to assess whether the minimum eligibility requirements for participation in the next phase of the competition were still met by the consortium despite the withdrawal of the applicant “398-Synergie IT”;
- On 23 July 2025, the Evaluation Committee met and, following a thorough review, established that the final score remains unchanged, and therefore the consortium retains the right to access to the second phase of the tender procedure;

Take the following decisions:

- 1) To admit the consortium “Emmaüs Connect+Synergie IT” to the second phase of the tender procedure;
- 2) To inform the consortium of the updated evaluation outcome by email;
- 3) To publish the present decree on the CLIMABOROUGH website.
