The results of phase 1 of the Follower Cities Call for Tender are out



CLIMABOROUGH, in close collaboration with the cities of **Prijedor, Grenoble-Alpes, Sofia, Pilsen, and Issy-les-Moulineaux**, recently launched its second Call for Tender. This initiative, coordinated by **ANCI Toscana**, invited innovators across Europe to propose solutions in key areas of climate action.

The call was structured around an **innovative public procurement framework**, with a total value of **€1.2 million**, and officially closed on **May 30, 2025**.

We received **37 applications from 59 entities across the EU** — a great signal of the enthusiasm and creativity of Europe's innovation ecosystem.

We're excited to announce that the **results of Phase 1** are now **officially available**. All **successful applicants** have been **invited to submit a full technical offer by August 29, 2025 at 23:59 (Brussels time)**.

Within the CLIMABOROUGH project, a public procurement call awarded two entities to help Turin tackle the waste management challenge: RiVestiTO and Traccia-TO.

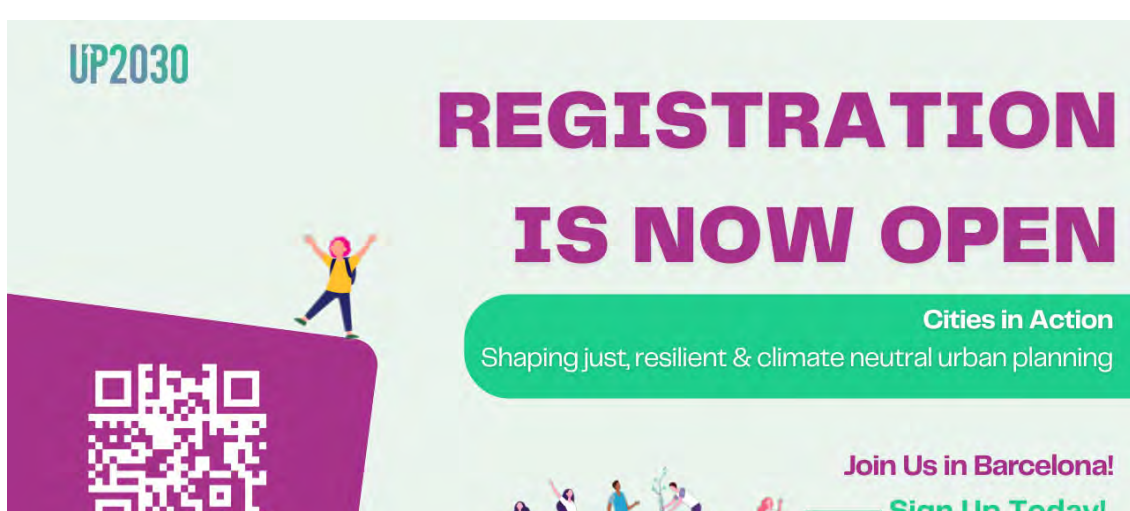

On 3 November in Barcelona, the **UP2030 project** will host its final event *Cities in Action: Shaping Just, Resilient & Climate Neutral Urban Planning*.
